## **US AIRWAYS MAINLINE FLEET**

### **AIRBUS A330-300:**

The A330-300 is US Airways' largest widebody aircraft, and features on-demand audio and video at every seat, enabling each passenger to start, pause, stop, fast forward, and rewind programs at any time. An extensive library of entertainment contains more than 65 hours of movies, music, and television programs with special programming for teens and children. Envoy Class passengers have the additional feature of an in-arm monitor with an 8.8 inch screen. The A330 offers 293 seats (30 Envoy class, 263 main cabin).

### **AIRBUS A330-200:**

The A330-200 is US Airways' newest widebody aircraft, and features on-demand audio and video at every seat with an extensive library of entertainment with hours of movies, music, television and video games. Other features are Live Text News, Voyager Air Show, and In-Flight Shopping. Special programming is available for children. Envoy Class passengers have the additional feature of a 12.1 inch screen. The A330-200 offers 258 seats (20 Envoy class, 238 main cabin).

### **AIRBUS A321:**

The A321 is a larger derivative of the Airbus A320 family of aircraft, with which it shares a high degree of commonality, including identical cockpit configurations, maintenance requirements and pilot ratings. The A321 offers 183 seats (16 first class, 167 main cabin).

### **AIRBUS A320:**

The A320 aircraft is a twin-engine, fuel-efficient aircraft that offers dual-class service and seats 150 passengers (12 first class, 138 main cabin).

### **AIRBUS A319:**

The A319 is a shorter derivative of the Airbus A320 family of aircraft, with which it shares a high degree of commonality, including identical cockpit configurations, maintenance requirements and pilot ratings. The A319 offers 124 seats (12 first class, 112 main cabin).

### **BOEING 767:**

The 767-200ER is one of US Airways' widebody aircraft, flying primarily transatlantic routes. The aircraft features audio and video entertainment systems, and seats 204 passengers (18 Envoy class, 186 main cabin).

### **BOEING 757:**

US Airways operates the twin-engine 757-200 jet aircraft primarily on long-haul domestic and Caribbean routes. It offers dual-class service and seats up to 193 (12 first class, 164 to 185 main cabin).

#### BOEING 737:

US Airways operates the 737-300 and the 737-400 series aircraft. The 737-300 offers 126 to 134 seats (8 to 12 First Class, 114 to 126 main cabin), and the 737-400 offers seating for 144 customers (12 first class, 132 main cabin).

#### EMBRAER 190:

US Airways' newest aircraft joined the fleet in December of 2006 and began flying in February 2007. The 190 features all leather seating and offers space for 99 passengers (11 first, 88 main cabin).

#### US AIRWAYS EXPRESS FLEET:

US Airways Express service is operated by eight regional carriers: wholly-owned US Airways subsidiaries Piedmont Airlines and PSA Airlines; and six affiliate carriers: Air Wisconsin, Chautauqua Airlines, Colgan Air, Mesa Airlines, Republic Airlines and Trans States Airlines.

US Airways Express features a fleet of jet and turboprop aircraft.
