Applies to Class 9 Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods listed on shippers declaration.

**Not accepting:** UN 3082 Hazardous Waste (liquid); UN 3077 Hazardous Waste (solid); UN 2807 Magnetized material; UN 2211 Polymeric bead, expandable; Lithium Batteries shipped under UN 3480, UN 3481, UN 3090, and UN 3091. Not accepting shipper built pallets containing dangerous goods.

Fee applies to each different UN # or ID # listed on the shippers declaration.

DG Fee does not apply to UN 3373 Biological Substances, Category B.

Accepting Envirotainers T1 & T2 models.

Not accepting shipper built pallets containing Dry Ice.

UN 3373 Biological substance, Category B shipments tendered for Premier Pak service are limited to 5.5 lbs (2.5 kgs) of dry ice or less per package.

Usage of over 5.5 lbs (2.5 kgs) of Dry Ice cannot exceed the maximum per piece as stated in the IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations, and cannot exceed aircraft limits.

All Class 9 Miscellaneous Dangerous Goods shipments (with exceptions), including Dry Ice that exceeds 5.5 lbs. (2.5 kg) per package must be booked prior to tender with the Cargo Contact Center and must move at PRI, PMF, or PPK levels. Dangerous Goods, UN 3373 and shipments containing Dry Ice accepted at US Airways Cargo facilities only and aboard mainline aircraft only.

Dangerous Goods and Dry Ice Fees subject to any applicable taxes, and subject to change without notice.
